Further, should you be selected as the successful offeror, your signature on the task order award serves as confirmation that the socio-economic status provided in the quotation is the same as that identified in the applicable GSA schedule, subject to the NAICS applicability defined in the BPA and the current associated size standards established by the Small Business Administration (SBA), as of the date of your signature on the task order award.**

Your quotation shall separately address: experience, functional approach, price, and socio-economic support. You are also required to submit an executed Organizational Conflict of Interest Certification for the prime contractor/team leader and any proposed subcontractors and/or team members, utilizing the format set forth in BPA Attachment 5.
