

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS IN RESPONSE TO ERP SUSTAINMENT RFI (W52P1J13ERPRFI). RESPONSES NOTED IN RED.

1. Q: Would the place of performance be at Rock Island Arsenal or Picatinny Arsenal? The notice indicates Rock Island, the RFI suggests Picatinny with the Government ERP Competency Center.

A: The place of performance is envisioned to be at various locations to support scope of services to PM AESIP, PM GFEBS, the Army Shared Services Center (Army-SSC) and any Army organization that is a stakeholder to these solutions. These locations include but are not limited to Picatinny Arsenal, NJ, Richmond, VA, Marlton, NJ, and the National Capital Region (NCR).

2. Q: Is this for a specific part of the Army's ERP program, like LMP? Or is it for all of the ERP programs (LMP, GFEBS, GCSS, AESIP, and AMIS)?

A: As delineated in the RFI, support is envisioned for PM AESIP, PM GFEBS, the Army-SSC and any Army organization that is a stakeholder to these solutions. PM AESIP includes LMP, GCSS-Army, AESIP Hub Products, and AMIS. Of these, AMIS is not an Army ERP and not included in this RFI.

3. Q: The services described in the "Scope of Services" section of the RFI are already available to the Army ERP community through the three (3) Army Enterprise Systems Integration Program (AESIP) contract vehicles: Enterprise Application Services (EAS), Enterprise Integration Services (EIS), and Enterprise Infrastructure Services (EInfs). The Army conducted significant market research prior to the release of the three AESIP solicitations, received multiple proposals in response to those solicitations, and made several awards to qualified businesses for two of the three solicitations (EAS and EIS have been awarded with EInfs still in source selection), so given that the EAS, EIS, and EInfs statements of work cover the services outlined in the subject RFI, what additional information is the Army seeking that has not already been addressed through the acquisition of the three AESIP contracts? Are the EAS, EIS, and EInfs statements of work insufficient to cover the scope of services outlined in the subject RFI, and if so, why?

A: Please review the RFI for the information being sought. Market research is required for all acquisitions on an ongoing basis in accordance with FAR 10. Please bear in mind that the EAS, EIS and EInfs contracts were written with finite ordering periods as IDIQs with guaranteed minimum values and overall ceiling values.

4. Q: Would it not be in the AESIP interest to use their currently awarded or soon to be awarded small business IDIQ contracts for this work?

A: The EAS, EIS and EInfs contracts (referenced in Question 3) were written with finite ordering periods as IDIQs with guaranteed minimum values and overall ceiling values. The Government is considering these limitations in formulating the acquisition strategy.

5. Q: Is this procurement going to be more of a system integration effort or program support services? The PWS was not clear.

A: This is a Request for Information (RFI) and not a Performance Work Statement (PWS). As delineated in the RFI, the Army envisions procuring ERP services to complete a product/project or plans to acquire specific skill sets to accomplish the RFI scope of services. The scope of ERP services included in the RFI are: Solution Architecture Services, Application Lifecycle Services and Support, Organizational Change Management, Compliance, Transition Services, Staff Augmentation, and Task Order Management. This RFI does not include program management support services. Please refer to Figure 1 labeled "Army ERP Program Support Framework."

6. Q: Who is the incumbent contractor is for this RFI and the contract number?
