Colonel Burr H. Miller serves as the Military Deputy for U.S. Army Contracting Command-Redstone Arsenal (ACC-RSA), the largest contracting center of the U.S. Army Contracting Command. He is responsible for assisting the Executive Director with oversight of a diverse contracting portfolio averaging over \$30 billion annually. He also maintains day-to-day communication with his military counterparts across the contracting and program management enterprise, while overseeing support to the Department of Defense. Prior to becoming the Military Deputy, he served as the Project Manager for the Aviation Mission Systems and Architecture Project Management Office within Program Executive Office (PEO) Aviation.



Col. Miller enlisted in the Army in 1989. Upon completion of Infantry Basic and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Benning, Georgia, he served as an enlisted Infantryman at multiple duty locations and achieved the rank of Staff Sergeant. In 1998, he commissioned into the Quartermaster Corps following graduation from Officer Candidate School. In 2006, he joined the Army Acquisition Corps.

Miller's acquisition experience includes service as: Assistant Product Manager for PEO Soldier-Rapid Fielding Initiative; Executive Officer for PEO Soldier; Assistant Product Manager for Personnel Recovery Support Equipment; Contract Specialist for PEO Aviation supporting PMO CH-47F; Deputy Chief of Staff G-5 (Future Plans) for the Army Expeditionary Contracting Command; Army Contracting Writing System- Capabilities Manager for Army Contracting Command; Product Manager for Aviation Mission Equipment, PEO Aviation; Deputy Project Manager for the Aviation Systems Project Office; Chief of Compliance and Policy for the 411th Contracting Support Brigade, Camp Humphreys, Korea and Director, Ronald Reagan Ballistic Missile Test Range Kwajalein Atoll-Marshall Islands;

Col. Miller holds a Master of Business Administration from Tarleton State University and is Level III certified in both contracting and program management through the Defense Acquisition Workforce Improvement Act. Col. Miller is also a 2021 graduate of the Air War College.
