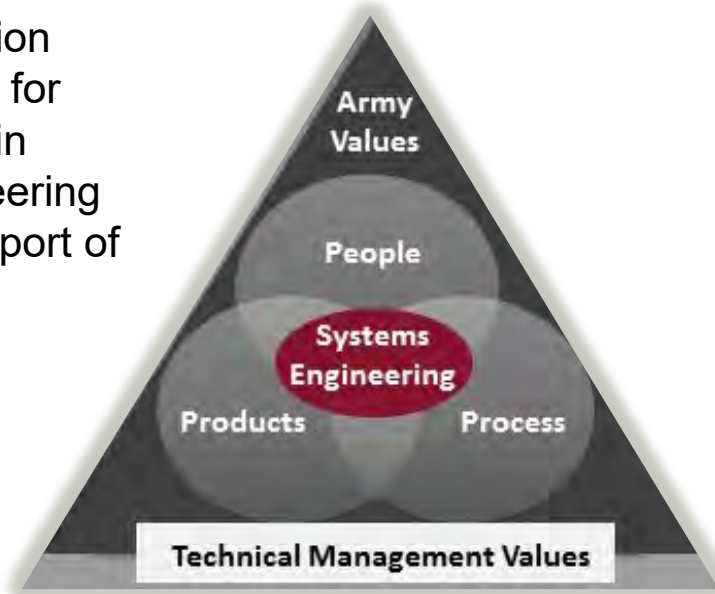


Purpose

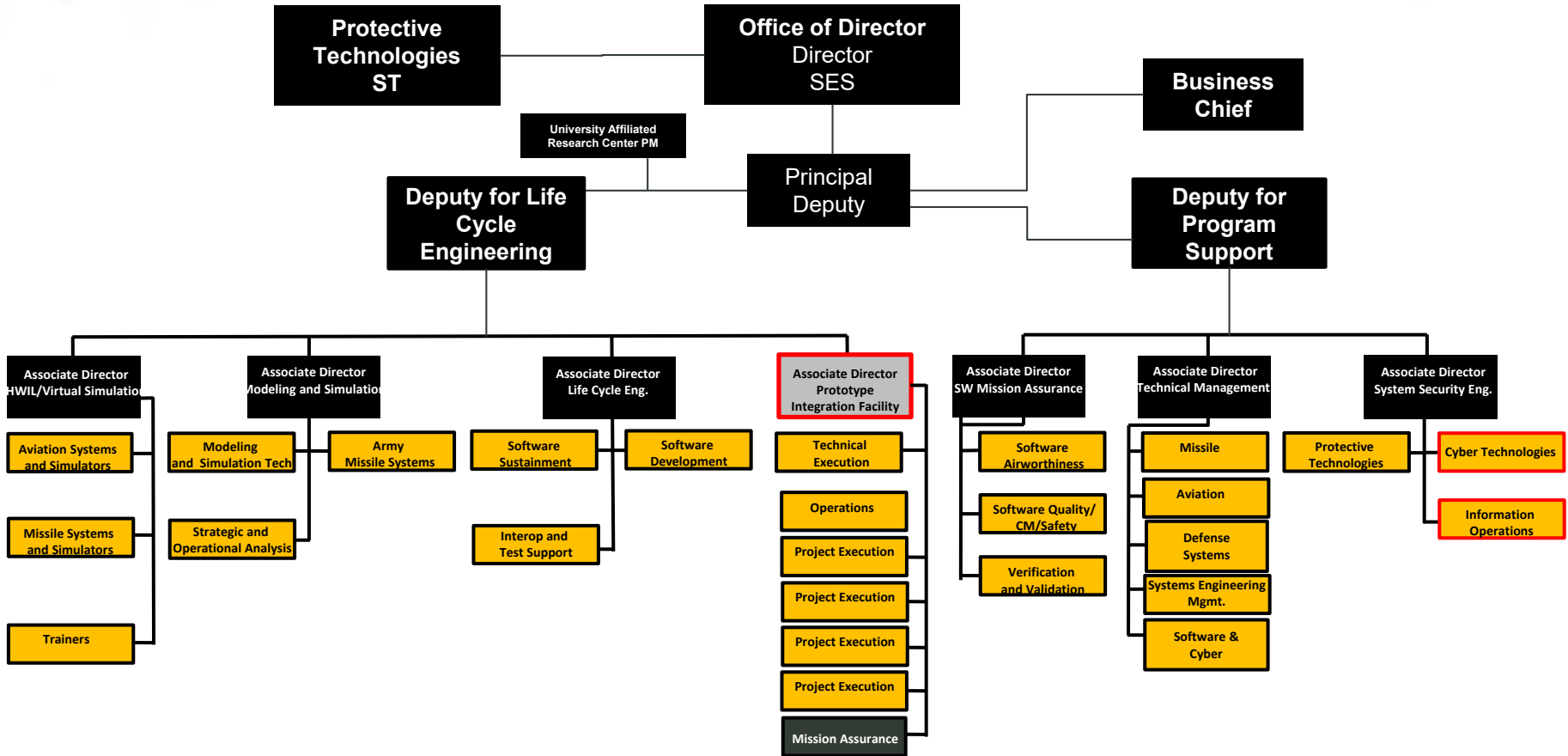

Tech Management SETA Support Contract Requirements



TASK ORDER OBJECTIVE



The Technical Management Associate Directorate of the Software, Simulation, Systems Engineering and Integration Directorate (S3I) has a requirement to provide technical support to the United States Government Organizational customers in the Redstone Arsenal Community. The objective of this Task Order is to provide the full range of technical support and expertise focused in the areas of Technical Management, Systems Engineering, Software, and Cybersecurity. The support to accomplish these tasks will be identified by individual Technical Directions (TDs) defining the specific work to be performed.





PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS



- Task performance location: Contractor or Government facilities
- The contractor shall provide the necessary trained personnel, technical support, equipment, and materials to meet the objectives and technical requirements in this PWS, and as further specified in the TDs.
- For each TD, the contractor shall submit a written Program Management Plan with their proposal detailing their proposed managerial approach as related to each of the functional areas as defined in this PWS. The Contractor shall submit an updated Program Management Plan to the contracting officer for approval 60 calendar days after contract award.
- For each Technical Direction issued under this contract, the contractor shall prepare status reports and funds and man-hour expenditure reports.
- The Contractor shall have a cost and performance management system which will track and report:
 - Period of performance
 - Current and accurate cost information
 - Actual dollars and hours spent
 - Remaining dollars and hours
 - Personnel assignments to include employee name, company, labor category, physical location and hours, burn out dates by employee name and invoice summaries
 - Identify all personnel gained and loss through the life of the contract. All information will be available per each TD number (TDN)
 - Provide access to the cost and performance management system for all specified Government officials
